



Supplies needed:

- Delicate Wings Paper Pumpkin Refill [164395]
- Pretty Peacock & Gold 3/8" (1 Cm)
 Metallic Ribbon [162588]
- Simply Scored [122334]
- Bone Folder [102300]
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]

Project Recipe:



1. Place an 8" \times 5-1/2" piece of cardstock onto the Simply Scored tool with the 8" side in the landscape position. Score the card at 1/2", 3", 4-1/4", and 6-3/4" on the 8" side. Rotate the card base 90°, then score it at 1-1/4", 4" and 4-3/4" on the 5-1/2" side. (Tip: When using pattern paper with a direction make sure the 1-1/4" panel will be the bottom of the bag.)



2. Fold all the score lines on the cardstock, burnishing the folds with a bone folder. Trim the card base according to the diagram, cutting along the red score lines and removing the grayed-out panels. Fold along the score lines again, and apply MultiPurpose Liquid Glue to the 1/2" tab and the bottom tabs. Assemble the bag by adhering the glued tabs together.



3. Use a corner rounder to round the corners of the tab at the top of the bag. Fold the tab over, then punch two holes through all layers of the top panel. Thread a ribbon through the holes and tie it into a bow.



4. Decorate the front of the bag using elements from the Delicate Wings Paper Pumpkin Kit.
