More Than Autumn Pumpkin Spice Latte Packet Holder



Supplies needed:

- More Than Autumn Bundle (English)

- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708]
- A Little Latte 12" X 12" (30.5 X 30.5 Cm) Designer Series Paper [163453]
- Early Espresso 8-1/2" X 11"
 Cardstock [119686]

- Crumb Cake 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock
 [120953]
- Calypso Coral 8-1/2" X 11"
 Cardstock [122925]
- Pecan Pie 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock
 [161717]
- Baker's Twine Essentials Pack
 [155475]
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]
 Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]
- Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [150673]

Project Recipe:



1. Cut a 1-7/8" x 10-1/2" piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score it at 4" and 4-1/2" on the 10-1/2" side, then fold along the score lines to create the packet holder.

Cut two 1-5/8" x 3-3/4" pieces of A Little Latte Designer Series Paper.

Stamp the coffee cup image from the More Than Autumn stamp set onto a 2" x 2-1/4" piece of Crumb Cake cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.

Next, stamp the coffee cup image again onto a scrap of A Little Latte Designer Series Paper using Memento Tuxedo Black ink, ensuring the cup wrap is stamped onto the paper (see photo for reference).

Stamp the pumpkin image from the More Than Autumn stamp set onto a 1" x 1" piece of Calypso Coral cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.

Then, stamp the cinnamon stick image from the More Than Autumn stamp set onto a scrap of Pecan Pie cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink.

Die-cut the coffee cup, pumpkin, and cinnamon stick images using the More Than Autumn Dies and a die-cutting machine.



2. Adhere the two 1-5/8" \times 3-3/4" pieces of Designer Series Paper to the latte packet holder using adhesive, as shown in the photo. Insert a latte packet into the holder, then secure it by tying a length of baker's twine around the holder, finishing with a bow on the left-hand side.



3. Assemble the coffee cup with the cup wrap, cinnamon stick, and pumpkin as shown, using adhesive and a Stampin' Dimensional for the pumpkin die-cut.

Adhere the assembled cup to the front of the latte packet holder using Stampin' Dimensionals.
