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Spooky Halloween Fun-Fold Card



Supplies needed:

- Spooky Halloween Bundle [166199]
- Spooky Halloween Photopolymer Stamp Set [166192]
- Spooky Halloween Dies [166198]
- Spooky Sweet 12" X 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper [166191]
- Everyday Arches Dies [164629]
- Petunia Pop Classic Stampin Pad [163811]
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708]
- Your Basic Black Cardstock [121045]
- Basic White Cardstock [166780]
- Petunia Pop Cardstock [163801]
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653] \$140.00
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]

Project Recipe:



Cutting Guide:

- Card Base = 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece of Basic Black cardstock . Score at 4-1/4" & 2-1/8" on the 8-1/2" side.
- Designer Series Paper = Cut one piece at 4" x 5-1/4" & two pieces at 1-7/8" x 5-1/4" & hippo die-cut.
- Basic Black = 4" x 2-1/2"
- Basic White = 4" x 2-1/2"

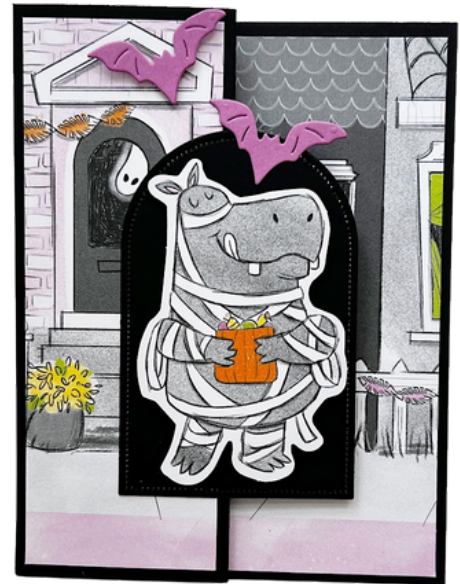
1. Fold an 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece of Basic Black cardstock in half at the 4-1/4" score line, then fold the front flap back along the 2-1/8" score line to create a fun-fold card base.
2. Adhere Designer Series Paper to each panel of the card base.





3. Cut an arch from the 4" x 2-1/2" pieces of Basic Black and Basic White cardstock using the Everyday Arches Dies and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. Stamp the sentiment and bat images onto the white arch using Petunia Pop and Tuxedo Black Memento inks. Adhere the arches to the card base as shown, ensuring the stamped white arch is hidden behind the Basic Black arch when the card is closed.

4. Cut bats from a scrap of Petunia Pop cardstock using the bat die from the Spooky Halloween Dies and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. Adhere the bats and the hippo cutout from the Spooky Sweet Specialty Designer Series Paper to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals as shown.



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
